Havana, Cuba! A Cold War world of suspicion, suspense and silliness. Amidst the sultry and seductive climes of Havana our heroes twirl, twitch and tango away from enemy agents, MI6 and the truth. Jim Wormold, a run-of-the-mill vacuum cleaner salesman turned accidental spy, resorts to fabricating ludicrous military reports in order to save his business and satisfy his decadent daughter, beginning a hilarious and improbable rise to the top of the British Secret Service.

Spies Like Us' award-winning debut production Our Man in Havana dissects the piercingly relevant themes of misinformation and corruption using only five actors and a vacuum cleaner in their trademark explosive physical style.

ABOUT THE COMPANY

Spies Like Us is an award-winning ensemble physical theatre company comprised of seven Young Pleasance graduates, started as part of the Pleasance Futures' XYP initiative. With a combined total of 32 Edinburgh and London fringe runs between them, Spies Like Us was formed to produce Our Man in Havana, their award-winning debut show (Theatre Weekly's "Best Fringe Debut" 2017) which played at the Edinburgh Festival Fringe as the Pleasance's 2017 XYP company, and which returned to bring a dash of Cuban sunshine to the last week of the 2018 festival. In 2018, they also produced a fresh and critically acclaimed adaptation of Buchner's Woyzeck that won Theatre Weekly's "Best Physical Theatre" award 2018 and Voice Magazine's "Pick of the Fringe" 2018.
